



Minutes of meeting of December 4, 2008

The meeting was called to order by President Bill Eason at 7 pm with the pledge of allegiance and the acceptance of the minutes of the last meeting. A bucket was passed for contributions for the East Ocean View Community Center Christmas Party.

Police Report – Project Safe Neighborhood was reinstated. Police in attendance were Todd Williams, Sgt. Gibbs, Lt. Mitchell, Officers Snyder and Lohmann. Overall vice/narcotics in East Ocean View have seen reduced activity in 2008.

Treasurer's Report was given and accepted.

Report on Thanksgiving Dinner at the East Ocean View Community Center – Because the event was so well attended a motion was made and seconded to increase the donation to \$800.

Tienda Jessy's asked for an ABC license to serve alcohol. The grocery and restaurant is open daily from 9 am to 10 pm. The motion was approved and passed to allow Tienda Jessy's to serve beer and wine on and off premises in the restaurant.

There was a membership update and President Eason asked for a volunteer to be membership chairman for each meeting.

Dues are now due. EOVCCL want to get a total of 200 members. More people have more influence with the city. We presently have 180 members.

Motioned and all in favor to cancel the January meeting. The first Thursday of January 2009 is a holiday (New Year's Day).

Focus Committee – A committee of members from all areas of East Ocean View is being formed to decide on the major items that the civic league will convey its needs to the city.

Barbara Lai of the city stated the electrical subcontractor has finished installing cameras and will be operational by Christmas and have feed going into the police station.

Wayne Green, Assistant to the City Manager was introduced. He had been submitted a list of questions to consider for the meeting. Mr. Green explained his and the city's approach to code violations. He stated "the civic league sets the priorities of what needs to be accomplished." Mr. Green answered questions.

As there was no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
