



East Ocean View Civic League Meeting – Minutes – Thursday, April 2, 2009

The meeting opened with the pledge of allegiance at 7 p.m. The minutes of the March meeting were approved.

Police Report - Officer Rodney Snyder gave the police report. Officer Snyder has a new partner and she will be present at the next meeting. Crime Prevention brochures were handed out. The crime in East Ocean View was up some the past month. With the warmer weather, we usually see an influx of juvenile activity. Give police a call if you see curfew violations for juveniles. The law is 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. curfew for children under 18 years old. You will begin to notice police ATVs on beach around May 1. Questions and answers followed. Bike licenses and registration are required in Norfolk. You can register a bike at the Police Station between 8-4 daily. The station is located at 2500 N. Military Hwy. Another question was raised about the amount of time it takes for police to show up after a 911 call is placed.

Rod Woolard, Director of Economic Development for Norfolk was the guest speaker. Mr. Woolard introduced Mike Cutter who works for the department and specializes in retail business development. Mr. Woolard explained that his department works to attract new business to the city. Performance based grants were discussed.

Dune Day – Dune Day, March 7, was a big success with 30-40 people present to plant grass on the dunes on 3rd and 5th Bay.

Bay Oaks Park – Results are that 3rd to 5th Bay has been set aside as a park.

The city Planning Meeting was March 26. On March 30 another city Planning meeting included East Ocean View.

Changes for Mona Lisa were passed by the City Council.

Needs Focus Committee Priorities Proposal – After discussion it was moved and seconded to accept the proposal. 1) Fix Flooding – Storm and Tidal; 2) Enhance Code Enforcement, with accountability and disclosure; 3) Down Zone all of East Ocean View and 4) Beautify and improve streetscapes.

Public Hearings - Two public hearings for Norfolk are scheduled for May 6 and May 7 at Granby High School. One hearing is for the city budget and the other for tax rate. Bill Eason, EOVCCL President will attend the budget hearing to present East Ocean View Needs Focus Committee Priorities Proposal.
